plr The first well-documented record of the name "Korazin" is found in 1327 in the Register of Hansa Visegrádensis (Visegrád is a town in northern Hungary, that is today in the region of Trencsén). On 15 April 1332 the town appeared in the state of Nikolsburg's register. At the latest, Korazin appeared in 1377 in the Papal chancery's registry. The town's name changed from Aa (a-z) to Korazin. The beginning of the 15th century witnessed a wave of devastation and destruction in the wake of the invasion of the Tatars and their devastation in Europe. In the Pomerelia, this affected most of the towns located in the region. It's written that Korazin's castle was burnt by the Tatars and also that the town's castle was destroyed by the Tatars and that 1363 (1362) twenty two houses, ten households and twenty two or twenty three tenant farmers were burned to the ground. The town walls were demolished in 1415. The first mention of the ruins of the town is in the 15th century - in a Turkish document from 1415. The site of the town is still visible in the center of Korazin. Between 1452 and 1474, a large wooden fortress was built next to the ruins of the medieval town. The castle remained in the possession of the Zmajski family until the end of the seventeenth century. In the 17th century, the Zmajski family built a new palace, which was situated in Korazin today. The next owner of the castle was the nobleman Miklós Kánya (1633–1663), who died childless. His cousin Miklós György de Nagy Kánya acquired the castle and the surrounding estates in 1663. The castle was then inherited by one of the owners of the Jagiellon family, József Oláh (1668–1732) on the death of his cousin Miklós György in 1730. József Oláh was a well-known collector of paintings and engravings. In the time of József Oláh's descendants, the castle was ruined and all valuables were
